5	Exhibitor Requirements		Allow any still exhibit; baked goods must be accompanied by a recipe		
6	Exhibitor Credentials		Rework write up. Need parents and leaders to enter name of person who will be wearing wristband -- modify online page for the division - use Description field to collect names.		
7	RV Camping		Have fees on entry form only, not in rules section		
8	RV Camping		Make sure all times for Sunday check-in are in sync in rules and on form.		
9	RV Camping		Dogs allowed in camping area? Service dogs -ok.		
10	General Rules		Stall signs - should have specific information required on them. No sponsors allowed on signs.

23	Dairy Goats		Eliminate Alpine as a separate breed division - they can be shown in AOP division.

25	Pygmy Goats		Question whether this show should be continued. No tri-county exhibitors have entered for last two fairs.		
26	Showmanship		Require for all large animal exhibitors.		
27	Round Robin	Remove "no whips are allowed" since this was changed for swine in 2022.	Might change equipment requirement.		
28	Round Robin		Add to rules that punching or beating animals is not allowed. Also announce this during mandatory Monday meeting.		
29	Round Robin		Have enough equipment for all participants.	We have a sponsor for this	
30	Pee Wee Showmanship		Add when sign-ups are open - Wed, 8 am to 2 pm (later?)
